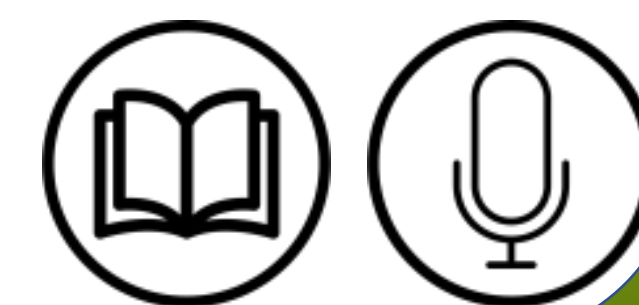
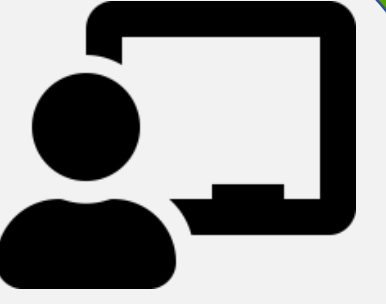


Addition and Conversion for Customary Units of Capacity





Addition and Conversion for Customary Units of Capacity



Example : 1

Add : 14 cups + 3 cups

Solution :

	Tens	Ones
	1	4
+	0	3
	1	7

So, 14 cups + 3 cups equals **17 cups**

So, answer is 17 cups

Convert 17 cups into fluid ounce

Solution :

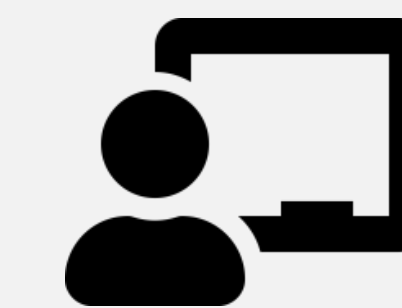
1 cup = 8 fluid ounces

17 cups = 8 x 17 fluid ounces
= 136 fluid ounces

So, 17 cups = 136 fluid ounces



Example : 2



Add : 11 pints + 13 pints

Solution :

	Tens	Ones
	1	1
+	1	3
	2	4

So, 11 pints + 13 pints equals **24 pints**

So, answer is 24 pints

Convert 24 pints into cup

Solution :

1 pints = 2 cups

24 pints = 2 x 24 cups
= 48 cups

So, 24 pints = 48 cups



Example : 3

Add : 12 quarts + 24 quarts

Solution :

	Tens	Ones
	1	2
+	2	4
	3	6

So, 12 quarts + 24 quarts equals **36 quarts**

So, answer is 36 quarts

Convert 36 quarts into pint

Solution :

1 quart = 2 pints

36 quarts = 2 x 36 pints
= 72 pints

So, 36 quarts = 72 pints

Example : 4

Add : 13 gallon + 26 gallon

Solution :

	Tens	Ones
	1	3
+	2	6
	3	9

So, 13 gallon + 26 gallon equals **39 gallon**

So, answer is 39 gallon

Convert 39 gallon into quart

Solution :

1 gallon = 4 quarts

39 gallon = 4 x 39 quarts
= 156 quarts

So, 39 gallon = 156 quarts

Example : 5

Add : 23 fluid ounces + 42 fluid ounces

Solution :

	Tens	Ones
	2	3
+	4	2
	6	5

So, 23 fluid ounces + 42 fluid ounces equals
65 fluid ounces

So, answer is 65 fluid ounces

Convert 65 fluid ounces into tablespoon

Solution :

1 fluid ounce = 2 tablespoones

65 fluid ounces = 2 x 65 tablespoones
= 130 tablespoones

So, 65 fluid ounces = 130 tablespoones
